*Micro-Noticing:
A Lens on Novice Teachers'
Trajectories of Learning to Notice*

Abstract: Participants will engage with research on the development of teacher noticing of students' mathematical thinking with videocases as authentic representations of practice. Micro-noticing, the moment-to-moment shift in teacher noticing, will be introduced as a lens to explore trajectories of development. Affordances and limitations will be discussed.

Background: No particular background required. Talk may be of particular interest to all students interested in teaching.

About the speaker: John is a post-doctoral researcher at SJSU. His research interests orient on trajectories of development for teacher noticing and of students' mathematics identities.
